We3-Park to Park Tour

Join us on a tour of two iconic parks in New York City: the renowned Central Park and the High Line, a park built on an abandoned elevated rail line that serves as a model for other railway-to-park conversions worldwide. Lunch will be at a traditional New York kosher deli. Then we will head downtown to explore the High Line, an excellent spot for photography and people-watching, before concluding our adventure with a Mexican vegan dinner.

Our first stop of the day will be Central Park, an urban oasis in the center of Manhattan, where we will embark on a guided tour of the southern end of the park, showcasing landmarks and great peoplewatching sites such as Bethesda Terrace, The Mall, The Ramble, and the Alice in Wonderland Statue. The tour concludes near Strawberry Fields, which honors the late Beatle John Lennon, who was tragically killed in front of his apartment building just steps from the park on the Upper West Side. After exiting the park, we will walk a few minutes to Pastrami Queen, a popular kosher deli.

After lunch, we will take the subway south to the High Line, an elevated railway transformed into a public park that offers stunning views of the Hudson River and the New York City skyline. Our guided tour will cover the 1.5-mile-long park, where we will explore its lush horticulture and art installations.

After the tour, we will take a break at Hudson Yards, Manhattan's newest neighborhood, featuring impressive buildings and a high-end shopping mall. Finally, we will enjoy an early dinner at Jajaja Mexicana, a vegan restaurant, before walking to Pier 83, where we will meet up with the rest of the group for a Circle Line Cruise.

- Please bring water, comfortable walking shoes, a hat, sunscreen, an extra layer for when it gets chilly, and a backpack to carry your belongings.
- Cost: \$36 per person (Includes NJ Transit from Elizabeth to NY Penn Station, tips for tour guides for both tours, and Mosaic administrative fees).
- Not included in the base price are the costs of lunch and dinner, as well as subway fees.
- Time: 8:00 am \sim 6:00 pm
- Expect to walk approximately five miles in total, broken up into parts.



8:05 am Depart Crowne Plaza Hotel - Newark Airport to walk to North Elizabeth train station.

Walking Directions from Hotel to Train Station (allow 30 minutes)

- 1. Walk out of Crowne Plaza Newark Airport beyond the gate and turn left. Stay off the road in the Motel 6 parking lot.
- 2. Use the sidewalks and crosswalks to cross over North Ave.
- 3. At the far corner of North Ave. and Spring Ave., turn right to cross over Spring Ave. (Rts. 1/9) to stay on North Ave. USE CROSSWALKS for safety.

4. Follow North Ave ½ mile / 6 ½ blocks to the NJ Transit North Elizabeth Train Station. Follow the driveway into the parking lot and up to the tracks. Do not cross under the tracks. If you find Stop &



8:38 a.m. Take the next NJ Transit Train (2 or 4 stops, depending on whether it is local or express) to New York Penn Station. DO NOT BOARD an Amtrak train, or you will pay more \$\$\$ to get to the same place.






